Current situation

- 1379/2013 incorporates 2406/96
- COM started Evaluation Roadmap finish to Q1-2019
- MAC decided 2406/96 needs renewal and revival
 - Situation has radically changed since 1996
 - European market depends on imports
 - Market standards require sustainabily inidcators (or not)
 - Need for a level playing field more pressing than ever before
- 2406/96 is mix of standard and working procedure



Many Changes since 1996

- Hygiene rules are in place
- Control regulation applicable
- CFP includes LO and is up for revision in 2022
- CMO includes PMP's
- EMFF funding different from FEOGA in 1996
- Brexit effective 2021 (UK will be a third country)
- What does post Lisbon renewal mean?
- Copy paste and update of 1996 situation?




Future: Mix of Public and Private (!?)

Building multi-stakeholder consensus






Development of standards (ISO/CEN)

2) Preparatory stage [optional]	Working Draft (WD)	Working Draft (WD)
3) Committee stage [optional]		Committee Draft (CD)
4) Enquiry stage [mandatory]	Draft European Standard (prEN)	Draft International Standard (DIS)
5) Approval stage [optional]	Draft European Standard for Formal Vote (FprEN)	Final Draft International Standard (FDIS)
6) Publication stage [mandatory]	NEN-EN	NEN-EN-ISO (or NEN-ISO or ISO)

 - •Is this novel, is this (im)possible, is it win win or lose lose?
 - Get input from stakeholders about their requirements on marketing standards
 - General principles
 - Direct Capture requirements
 - Imports specifics
 - Consumer requirements
- •Report on first phase and propose for next phase in autumn 2018
