 - Discussed in WG. Council's position recently adopted. To be included in Year 6

(4) Brexit and implications for the market

- Once the results from the negotiations on the future partnership are known.
 - Advice adopted on 11 June. Reply on 30 June 2021
 - + Advice on bivalve molluscs on 14 April. Reply on 23 June 2021

(5) Ecolabels and Certification Schemes

- Based on workshop report outcomes, in January-March 2021
 - Advice adopted on 15 June. Reply on 30 June 2021

(6) CATCH IT System

- Once the provisions on the mandatory use per the EU Member States and their national operators are published in the Official Journal
 - Legislative process on the revision of the Control Regulation still ongoing
