COVID-19 PANDEMIC

MAC Advice on Impact and Mitigation of the COVID-19 Pandemic on the Seafood Supply Chain – information on Commission's Reply

Advice adopted on 11 December 2020

DG MARE reply on 10 February 2021

- Launch of communication campaign "Taste the Ocean"
- Continued vigilance to limit obstacles to movement of goods
- Financial support for investments: Provisional agreement on EMFAF
- 100% rate of public aid for small-scale coastal fisheries under EMFAF
- Specific COVID-19 compensation scheme under 2021-2027 EMFAF
 - For economic losses & additional costs of individual operators
 - For activation of CMO storage mechanism by POs
- Retroactive eligibility and exceptional measures
- EMFAF investment for greater resilience of the value chain
 - Mutual funds + insurance instruments
 - Creation of POs + implementation of production and marketing plans
