Consideration of Draft Advice	Functioning of the Common Fisheries Policy	Under Article 49 of the CFP Regulation, COM must provide a report on the results of its application by 31 December 2022. The CFP report will be elaborated and delivered in parallel with a report on the functioning of the CMO. COM launched a targeted consultation and the deadline for replies is 28 February 2022. EP is preparing an own initiative report on “state of play in the implementation of the CFP and perspectives after 2020”. Rapporteur MEP Gabriel Mato sent a questionnaire to Advisory Councils on the topic. The Secretariat circulated a questionnaire, based on a selection of market-related questions from the targeted consultation and MEP Mato’s questionnaire, and asked for feedback from 6 January to 21 January 2022. Based on the feedback received, the Secretariat prepared a proposal of draft advice.	Consideration, paragraph by paragraph, of the draft text. The Secretariat circulated the questionnaire and asked for feedback from 23 December 2021 to 17 January 2022. Based on the feedback received, the Secretariat prepared a proposal of draft advice.
