Decision	Russian Invasion of Ukraine	Following a large-scale military build-up and weeks of extreme tensions, on 24 February 2022, Russia launched an invasion of Ukraine. The EU condemned Russia's military aggression and has progressively adopted packages of sanctions, while providing assistance to Ukraine. The Management Team and the Secretariat maintain informal exchanges with MARE A4 to transmit information from individual members concerning impacts on the market.
