Decision	Secretariat	In line with the Rules of Procedure, the Executive Committee shall appoint and dismiss the Secretariat. The current services contract, which followed a tender procedure, will conclude on 30 September 2023. At the 8 June 2023 meeting, it was agreed, as an action point, that the Chair would prepare different proposals on the structure of the Secretariat. Following a recruitment procedure by an Evaluation Committee, the Executive Committee approved the candidate selected for the Secretary General position.
