➤ EU-China Blue Partnership Forum for the Oceans (23 September 2023)

- Pedro Reis Santos (Secretary General)
 - Opening remarks by Commissioner Sinkevičius
 - Importance of shared knowledge and experience
 - Strong partnership, under a rules-based global order, to improve the global ocean framework
 - Calls for ocean protection, sustainable fisheries, fight against IUU, sustainable use of marine resources & MPAs, using international agreements
 - Strong partnership, under a rules-based global order, to improve the global ocean framework
 - Opening remarks by Youxiang Ma, Vice-Minister, Agriculture and Rural Affairs
 - Very productive & fruitful communication with EU on IUU (meetings, exchanges, joint efforts)
 - Called for healthy development of aquatic industries between EU and China, solidarity and cooperation on climate change, work based on mutual reciprocity
 - Strengthen efforts on IUU + protection of sustainability of fishing industry
 - Collaboration in science (fisheries resources, genetic resources, processing, disease control, energy saving, equipment update, resources restoration)
 - Expand market access and free trade + more joint development projects

 - Opportunities for collaboration on blue growth + ocean energy
 - Concept of "community for future of mankind" = Human & ocean ecosystem together
 - Principles of mutual respect, equal treatment, extensive communication
 - EU & China: Strong ties & relationship | Blue economy can bring benefits for both
 - Invest in intelligent ports, blue investments, blue finance
 - Climate change: protect biodiversity + research + ocean carbon sinking mechanisms

 - Session 2 Xinzhong Liu, Director-General, Bureau of Fisheries
 - Unbalanced distribution in the resources and development across regions
 - "All-encompassing approach to food" respecting national conditions & reality
 - Flag State obligations (RFMOs limit on number & tonnage of fishing vessels + fishing quotas, data collection system for distant water fisheries, observer system for transhipment, electronic fishing logbook for high seas)
 - Combat IUU fishing (supervise high seas transhipment, import & export validity certification, zero tolerance against IUU, annual "blacklist" of vessels)
 - Science & technology support (establishment & improvement of support system, compliance training, fisheries resources surveys)
 - Fisheries cooperation (high-level dialogues, conferences)

 - Session 2 Roberto Cesari, Head of Unit for IUU Fisheries Policy
 - EU & China must be leaders of implementation of Agenda 2030 and SDG14
 - Welcomed signing of BBNJ agreement and deposit of WTO agreement
 - EU & China must work in all oceans & RFMOs (manage stocks, strengthen food security, conservate biodiversity)
 - Importance of science, data, transparent legal environment, fight against IUU fishing
 - Highlighted EU's IUU "carding" system & new CATCH IT system + encouragement of voluntary use of the system by China
 - Appreciation for EU-China cooperation under IUU Working Group

- Costs of In-Person Meetings: 19 & 20 September 2023 WGs, GA, ExCom (example)
 - Meeting venue (Copa Cogeca): 3,467.20 €
 - Catering (lunch & coffee breaks): 5,208.85 €
 - Interpreters (EN, ES, FR): 6,098.40 €
 - Reimbursements (travel, accommodation, per diem): 19,240.81 € (29 reimbursements)
 - Total: 34,015.26 €

Advantages of In-Person Meetings:

- Networking (w/ other members, COM & MS representatives)
- Informal negotiations during breaks / lunch
- "Team building"
- More focus from the members on one task
- Easier for Chair & Secretariat to interpret the reactions of members (e.g., approval vs disapproval)

Disadvantages of In-Person Meetings:

- Higher costs (room rental, catering, reimbursements)
- Travel time and effort

- Costs of Hybrid Meetings: 23 & 24 May 2022 WGs, ExCom (example)
 - Meeting venue (Martin's Hotel Brussels EU): 5,537.26 €
 - Catering (lunch & coffee breaks): 5,909 €
 - Audiovisual & technicians: 5,537.26 €
 - Interpreters (EN, ES, FR): 6,001.60 €
 - Reimbursements (travel, accommodation, per diem): 3,935.70 € (8 reimbursements)
 - Total: 26,920.19 €

• Advantages of Hybrid Meetings:

- More flexibility for members to participate
- Easier to invite external experts

Disadvantages of Hybrid Meetings:

- Uncertainty for venue size & catering
- Feeling of "two separate meetings"
- More difficult to network (including uncertainty for travelling members on added value)
- More concentration required from Chair & Secretariat to follow developments online + in-person

- Costs of Online Meetings: 27 30 March 2023 WGs, ExCom (example)
 - Meeting venue (Zoom): 107.68 € (per month)
 - Interpreters (EN, ES, FR): 8,179.60 €
 - Zoom support expert: 2,044.90 €
 - Total: 10,332.18 €

• Advantages of Online Meetings:

- Low cost when compared to other meetings
- Easy attendance for members, observers, experts

Disadvantages of Online Meetings:

- Harder to network
- Higher likelihood of members "multitasking" during meetings
- Harder for Chair & Secretariat to interpret the reactions of members (e.g., approval vs disapproval)
