A questionnaire was circulated from 3 to 15 January 2024.		
Information	Consumer Information	In March 2021, the Aquaculture Advisory Council adopted a recommendation on consumer information, which urges the Commission to reinforce adequate and reliable consumer information in the HORECA sector. At their 24-25 October 2023 Working Group 3 meeting, the Aquaculture Advisory Council decided to follow-up on their recommendation with the Member States, potentially in collaboration with the MAC. At the 30 November 2023 meeting, the Working Group agreed to proceed with the establishment of a joint focus group on consumer information at HoReCa's level.
