

- Respect for workers and neighboring communities while operating in a socially responsible manner







## **Human Rights in the ASC Standards**



All ASC's 11 species-specific Standards and the Feed Standard contain criteria that work for the protection of the human rights of employees and those who live in communities surrounding the farms and feed mills.



The ASC Farm Standard, which will be released in 2024, further strengthens human rights protections.





### **ASC is Not Just About the Standards**



- ISEAL's three Codes of Good Practice provide a globally recognised framework, defining practices for effective and credible sustainability systems.
- o Those fully compliant with all three codes become an ISEAL member
- ASC is full member as of 2015 voluntarily scrutinized by peers

#### 1. The ISEAL Standard-setting Code

Defines how a standard should be developed, structured and improved over time. The Code addresses multistakeholder consultation and decision-making, and ensures the standard contains clear requirements that can be measured and assessed.

#### 2. The ISEAL Assurance Code

Provides a framework for assessing compliance with standards, so that consumers, supply chain partners, investors and other stakeholders know they can trust the results of assessments. It encourages assurance that is rigorous and accessible, providing accurate and transparent results.

#### 3. The ISEAL Impacts Code

Supports robust monitoring and evaluation that helps systems to understand how effective their standards are in achieving what they set out to do. It provides standards with a roadmap to measure progress against sustainability goals and to improve practices over time.

### **ASC Farm Certification Process**


# Independently done by 3<sup>rd</sup> parties – without any involvement from ASC


- ✓ ASC has set out clear rules for the certification process that is done by
  a team of qualified auditors (social & environmental)
- ✓ <u>Certifiers are supervised by ASI to assure consistent performance of audits</u>
- ✓ **Stakeholder consultation** during on-site audit & on draft audit report
- ✓ System of major and minor non-conformities; they **need action** to be **closed**
- ✓ Transparency: announcement, audit report & certification decision (even failed audits)
- ✓ Annual surveillance and unannounced audits on at least 10% of single site certificates
