		products. In April 2021, STECF published a report on		
		criteria and indicators to incorporate sustainability		
		aspects, which includes the recommendation of a		
		scoring system. In 2023, the MAC expressed the view		
		that the Sustainable Food System Framework would be		
		the most appropriate policy option for the		
		incorporation of the measurement and communication		
		on environmental and social sustainability. Even though		
		the Sustainability Food System Framework's labelling		
		system is currently on hold, STECF continued to work on		
		three fisheries-specific indicators (impact on seabed,		
		impact on targeted stocks, impact on sensitive species).		
		In December 2023, an Expert Working Group worked on		
		the last two mentioned indicators. The report was		
		presented at the 3 April 2024 meeting. At the 4 June		
		2024 meeting, draft advice on the development of		
		sustainability indicators was considered. It was agreed,		
		as an action item, that the Secretariat would revise the		
		draft advice and recirculate.
