Additional rules - Article 58 – paragraph 12

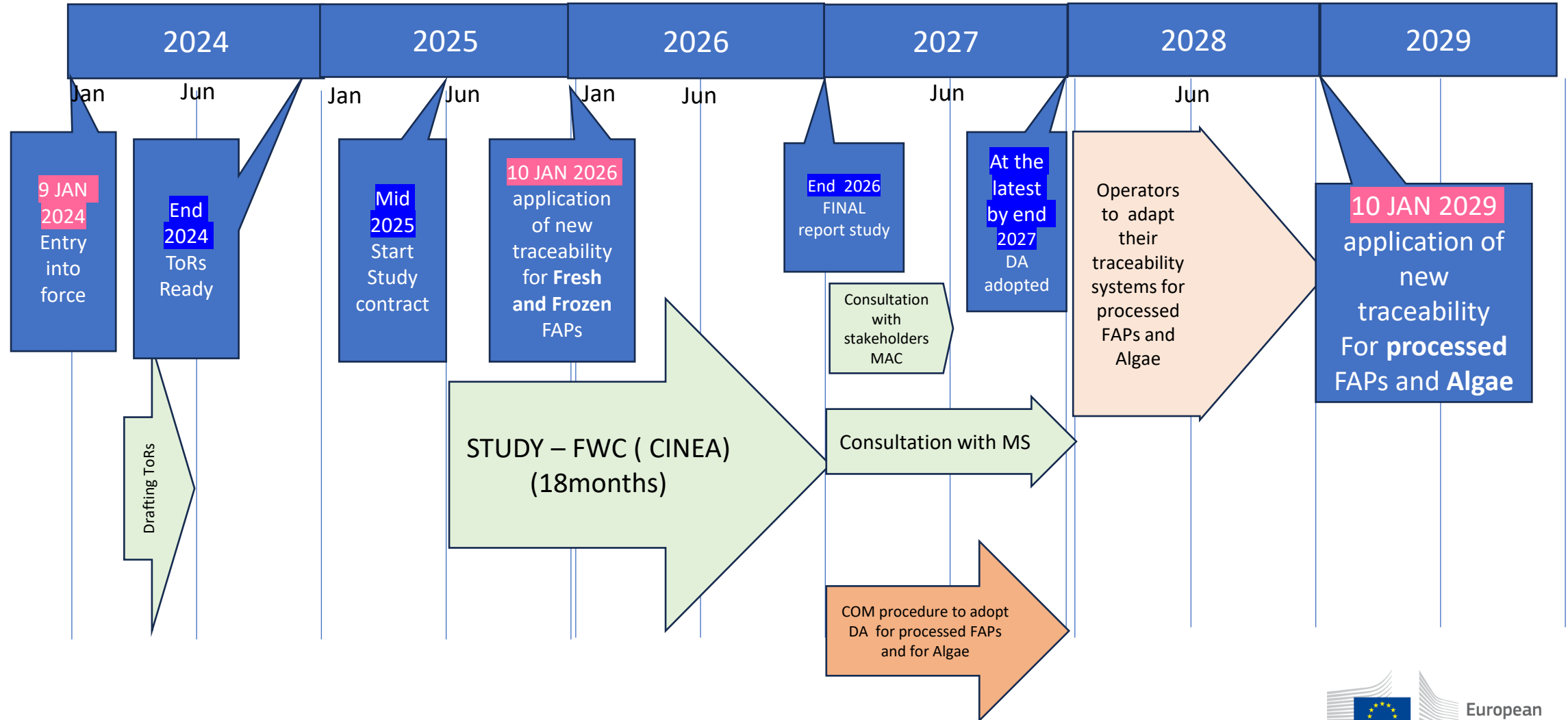
- What: 2 articles to be part a broader delegated act
 - **Article XX**
Traceability information of lots of fisheries and aquaculture products falling under Chapter 3 of the Combined Nomenclature established by Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87
 - **Article YY**
Marking of lots of fishery and aquaculture products
- When: since 2 December 2024.
 - Meeting with MSs on 11 December 2024.
 - MS Comments received by mid-january 2025: few comments received DE, NL, FI, LV,
 - Slightly revised articles – 2nd round on consultation with MSs by mid-february 2025
 - Interservice service consultation – March/April 2025
 - Consultation of European Parliament
 - **Adoption June/July 2025**

Study on traceability of specific FAPs

Article 58 – paragraph 9

- Study launch by CINEA under FWC mid December 2024 (18 months duration)
- Unfortunately **NO offer received**
- Decision to re-launch the study ASAP with more flexible timelines for submission of offer
- Aim: get at least one good offer to kick start **by June 2025 at the latest**

Timeline: 2024 – 2029
