# Additional rules - Article 58 – paragraph 12

## Delegated act

- What: 2 articles to be part a broader **delegated act**
  - **Article XX**  
Traceability information of lots of fisheries and aquaculture products falling under Chapter 3 of the Combined Nomenclature established by Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87
  - **Article YY**  
Marking of lots of fishery and aquaculture products
- When:
  - Finalisation of consultation with Member States – May 2025
  - Commission procedure for finalisation and adoption of the document – Summer/Autumn 2025
  - Presentation to the Expert meeting in summer 2025
  - Consultation of European Parliament and Council in Autumn 2025

- The consortium is bound by confidentiality rules; all information collected during interviews or data provided will be treated **as strictly confidential**.

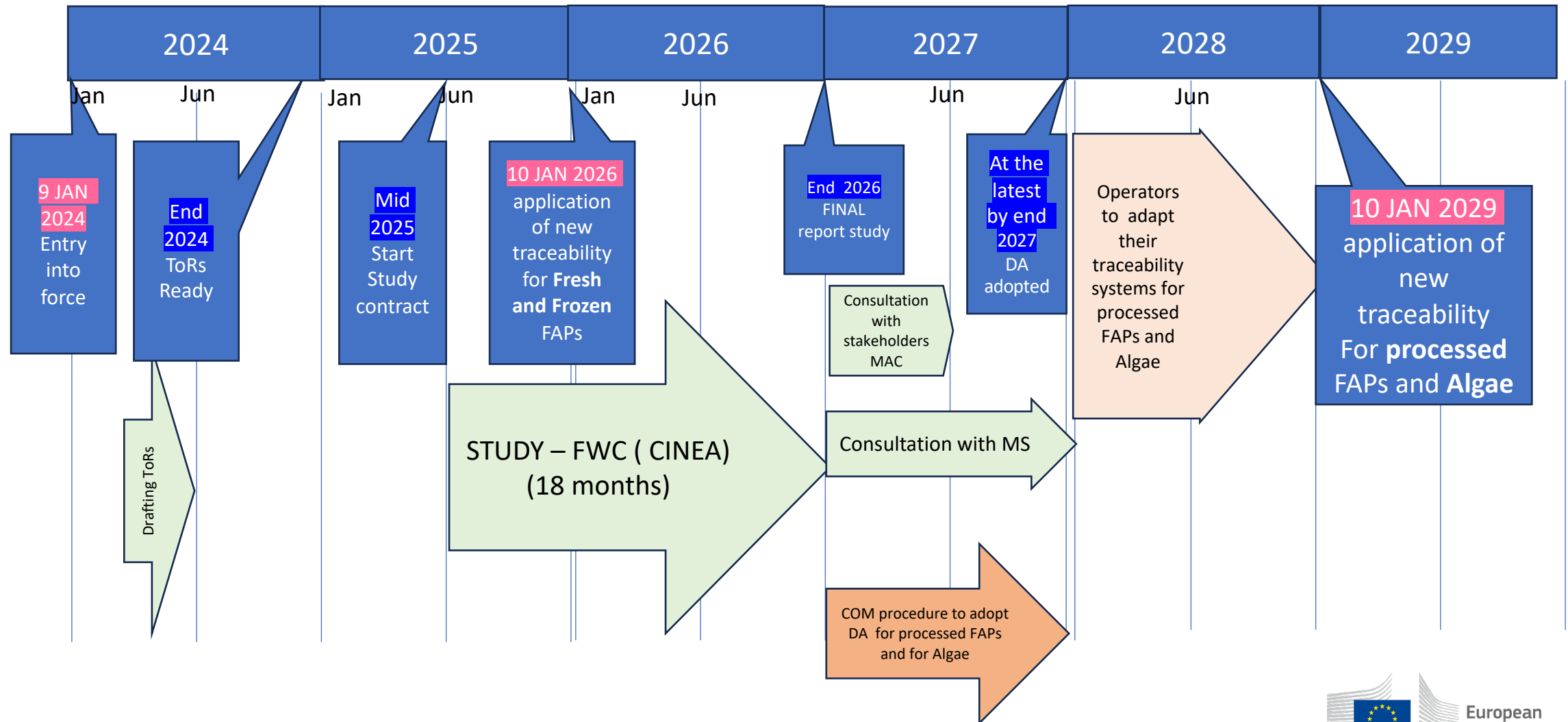
# Study on traceability of specific FAPs

## Article 58 – paragraph 9

### MAC contribution

- Provide relevant materials or inputs – Any national or EU-level studies, reports, or recommendations that go beyond those already available on the MAC website.
- Support in **case study countries** (ES, FR, IT, DE, NL, DK, PL, PO) – by facilitating fieldwork through national associations, suggestions of companies and other relevant stakeholders who may be willing to participate **in interviews and/or answer a written questionnaire (June-October 2025)**.
- Engage in the **validation workshop** – MAC will be invited to participate **in the validation workshop** later in the study (2026).
