





Organizing Committee

The Organising Committees (OCs) are ad-hoc taskforces composed of members who volunteer to assist in shaping the agenda of each EFF event. All EFF members can join OCs for scheduled events.



Each OC is led by <u>at least</u> one leading MEP, who hosts the event and makes the final decisions on the title. focus, speakers, agenda, and final date. The leading MEP is a Political member who volunteers to host the approved event.

While the event topic and the time of the year are decided in the Programming Committee annual meeting and confirmed by the Steering Committee, the leading MEP is responsible for the event and makes final decisions on the title, focus, speakers, agenda and final date.

The final title of the event is collectively determined, accompanied by a concise event description, which is typically assigned to one of the OC members and amended by all the others.



After the event, the OC dissolves.

MEMBERSHIP FEES

All activities of the European Food Forum (EFF) are fully funded by membership fees. This approach ensures the EFF's independence and its commitment to not taking any positions. Therefore the EFF does not accept sponsorships. Members of the European Parliament: No fees

Other Members (Annual Fee)

Business Members

- Standard fee: 11.000 Furos
- Small & Medium sized* enterprises: 2.200 Euros (as per EU recommendation 2003/361, companies with less than 250 employees on their payroll, an annual turnover not exceeding 50 million euros and/or an annual balance sheet total not exceeding 43 million euros, and no more than one third of their capital owned directly or indirectly by a larger company).
- Food, Agriculture and Retail Associations:
 - Standard fees: 5.500 Euros
 - Associations with an annual budget below 300.000 Euros: 2.750 Euros
- Sector Association:
 - Standard fee: 5.500 Euros
 - Associations with an annual budget below 300.000 Euros: 2.750 Euros


Public Institutions & Civil Society Members
