COMPACT PROFILE – ASSOITTICA ITALIA

Assoittica Italia is the national association representing companies involved in the processing, marketing and distribution of seafood products in Italy. Founded in 1986, it currently brings together more than **120 member companies**, with a combined turnover exceeding **€15 billion** and more than **10,000 employees**.

The Association supports the entire seafood supply chain, dealing with food safety, traceability, sustainability, regulatory affairs, customs procedures, tariffs, international trade, seafood promotion and innovation. Its member companies operate across the main segments of the sector, ranging from fresh, frozen and deep-frozen products to preserved and processed seafood products.

Over the years, Assoittica Italia has **established collaborations** with Ministries, Competent Authorities, Universities, Experimental Zooprophyllactic Institutes, research bodies, official laboratories and national and international organizations, while actively **participating in the main technical working groups** dedicated to the development of the seafood sector.

The Association is also engaged in **training and international cooperation activities** and collaborates with several partner countries to strengthen seafood supply chains, improve food safety, traceability and sustainability standards, and create new business opportunities. Cooperation agreements are currently in place with several African, Asian and Mediterranean countries.

Among its most recent international initiatives is the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding with the **Marine Products Export Development Authority (MPEDA)** aimed at promoting training activities, technical assistance, access to the European market and business relations between Indian and Italian operators.

For several years, Assoittica Italia has promoted the **Seafood Industry Academy**, one of Italy's leading professional training programmes dedicated to the seafood sector, highly appreciated by companies, industry professionals and Competent Authorities.

The Association is strongly committed to the promotion and enhancement of seafood products and has developed **NUTRIENinFISH**, the largest nutritional database dedicated to fisheries and aquaculture products, which has become a reference tool for companies, researchers, health professionals and institutions.

Assoittica Italia collaborates on a regular basis with the FAO and numerous international partners on projects focused on seafood supply chain sustainability, food safety, professional capacity building and the empowerment of women in the fisheries and aquaculture sectors.

Assoittica Italia is also the founder of **RE.N.IS.A.IT. – School of Fish Chefs**, the Italian national network of hospitality and culinary institutes committed to promoting seafood culture and training future professionals in the restaurant and hospitality sectors.
